## **Tyler Test Garden Selections**

The first round of selections for the proposed Rhododendron Hybridizer's Test Garden at the Tyler Arboretum have been made. Although they originally planned to showcase the creations of local hybridizers from Pennsylvania, they did extend eligibility to plants developed in areas within 200 miles of Philadelphia. The poster made by Tom Ahern pictured to the right shows images of those first-round selections. The committee is now taking cuttings to propagate those plants and will grow them for a couple of years before planting them out at Tyler. The poster and full list of hybrids will be on display at the ARS Fall Meeting in Gettysburg in the near future.

We did have several favorites from our District 9 make the cut. Those included 'John C. White' and 'Gilbert Myers' which were Rhododendrons of the Year in our region. Two new hybrids were selected, too. One is a cross by Sandra McDonald of ('Kluis Sensation' x 'Caroline') that is growing in the Beaudry garden. It will be registered as 'Kenny Mac' in honor of Sandra's late husband, Ken. The other is lovely pink that Bob and Rosa McWhorter raised from seed they got from our chapter seed exchange. It was a cross your editor made of ('Scintillation' x 'Apritan'). We have all admired it and they expect to register the hybrid next spring.
